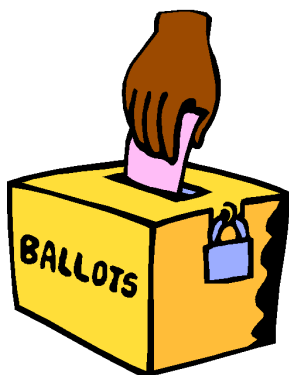
**2019 HOA dues to remain at
